

Hall

Situation and access	On ground floor of complex, at rear of church Access through two side doors: main entrance point is from side lane on left of church (if facing church), other entrance is from car park, but only to be used if needing to use car park, to take in equipment etc. Can also be accessed from church, if both are required. Full disabled access and toilet facilities.
Suitable for	Services, concerts, large or small meetings, fairs, sales of work, dance classes, drama groups, clubs and societies, community or special interest groups, seminars, conferences, public meetings.
Capacity	Can take 100 if seated theatre style, but may be fewer depending on the type of event.
Refreshments	Kitchen facilities for making tea, coffee, preparing cold food, or reheating prepared food and soup in the ovens. Outside caterers are welcome, although they may wish to see the kitchen first. Clients are expected to provide their own tea and coffee.
Music	Upright piano available. Stage at front for placing their own instruments, and sockets available for extension cables.
Audio equipment	Loop system available. Amplifier provided, 1 stand (or hand) microphone. Radio mikes not suitable for here.
Projectors and electrical equipment	Projector screen available. Will need to bring their own projectors, or computers for presentations. Plenty of sockets and extension cables to allow electrical equipment to be placed in different positions.
Heating	Heated by boiler, which is controlled by church managers only. No supplementary heating
Car Park/Public Transport	Available for 1 car if necessary for equipment. Public parking close by. Haymarket Metro station a 5 minute walk.
Smoking	No smoking is permitted anywhere on Church Grounds. The pedestrianised zone on Northumberland Road has seats and also bins where cigarette ends can be discarded.
